

Public Transport Routes to Coal Aston Village Hall

The best way to get there by public transport would be by train to Dronfield station and we can arrange to pick you up from there - it's only a few minutes drive from the Village Hall.

Please let us know in advance if you will need a lift to/from Dronfield Station.

There is an hourly service from Leeds via Sheffield with the 8.04 from Leeds arriving Dronfield at 9.15 and returning from Dronfield at 21.02 or 22.02.

There is also an hourly service from Nottingham via Chesterfield with the 8.17 from Nottingham arriving Dronfield at 9.02 and returning from Dronfield at 21.49 or 22.14.

Alternatively Stagecoach Bus Number 44 (Chesterfield to Sheffield (or Sheffield to Chesterfield) via Coal Aston) will take you to the Methodist Church, on Eckington Road, Coal Aston. The Village Hall is approx 3 minutes walk to the east. (If you're coming from Sheffield, you get off the bus and keep walking in same direction towards the Royal Oak and the Village Hall. If coming from Chesterfield, you will have passed the Village Hall and Royal Oak on your right, get off at the next stop (the Methodist Church) and walk back.)

From Sheffield catch bus number 44 towards Chesterfield on Arundel Gate, near the Howard Street Junction(Ag10), Sheffield Centre.
(Approx 7min walk from the station)

From Chesterfield catch bus number 44 towards Sheffield at Cavendish Street (Stop T2), Cavendish Street, Chesterfield
(Approx 8 min walk from the station)
